Here is a summary of what we have been doing during the last 6 weeks.

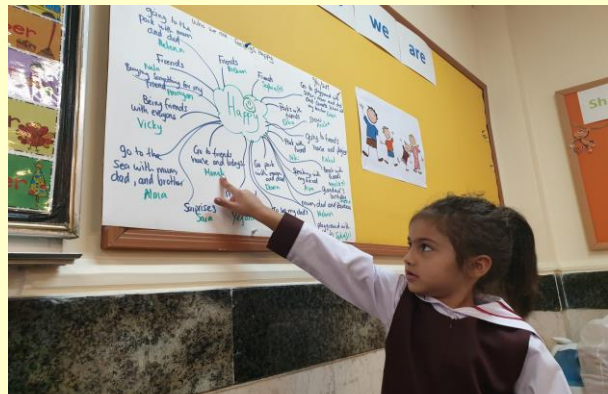
My face: We took a closer, more detailed look at our faces and drew the lovely details we saw.

My family: We took a look at our family photos and became more aware of our immediate family members.

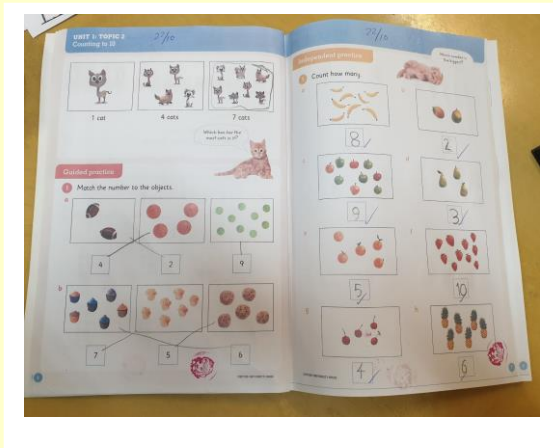
The 5 senses: We did experiments to test and explore our five senses: sight, hearing, smell, taste and touch.

LA:

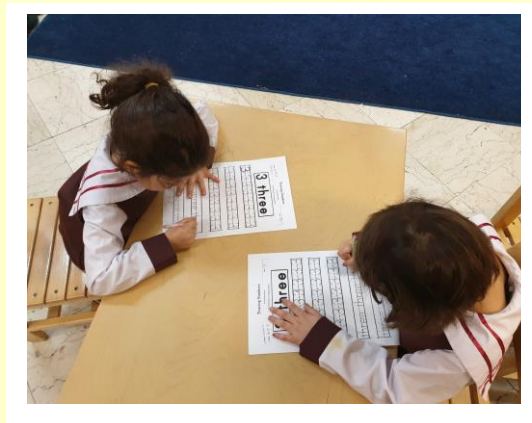
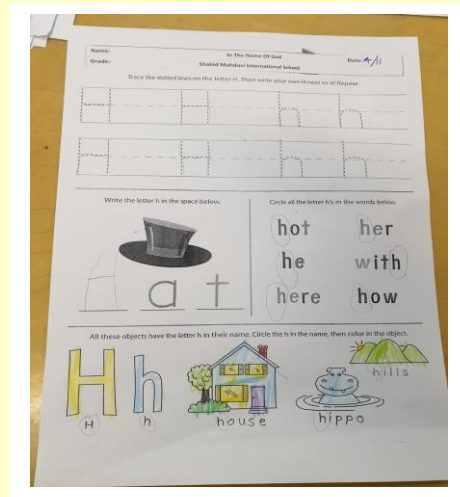
We have been learning these letters and their sounds:
