One of the activities of first graders was making puppet out of paper and ice cream stick.

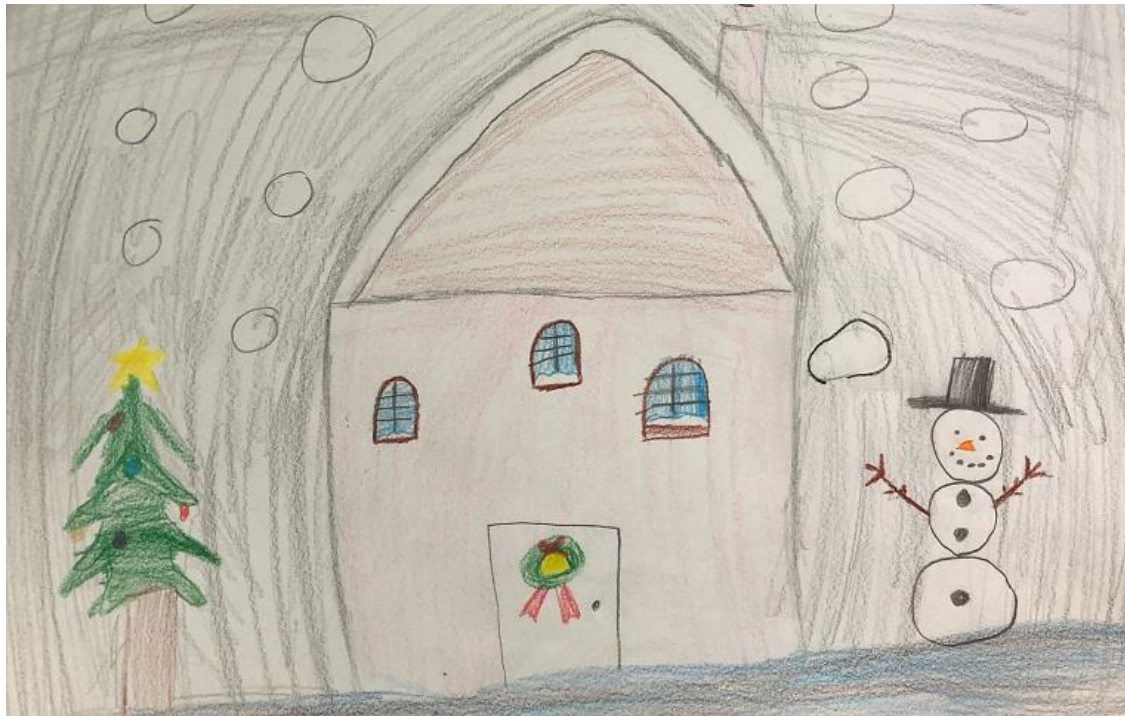
The students worked on Yalda night illustration and Christmas. They also practiced on coloring skills and free drawing in order to work on their imagination.
