My feelings: We had many discussions about what makes us happy, sad, angry and scared.

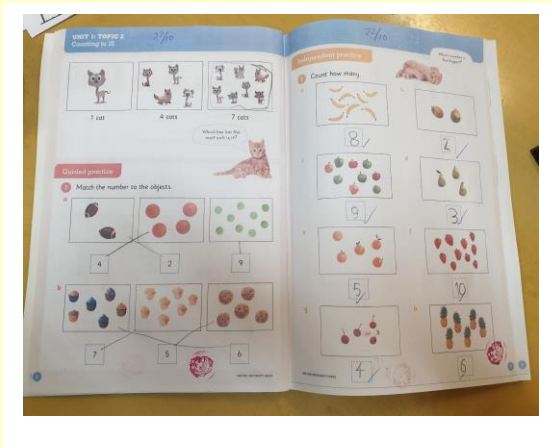
My family: We took a look at our family photos and became more aware of our immediate family members.

We have been working very hard in our math books on the following:

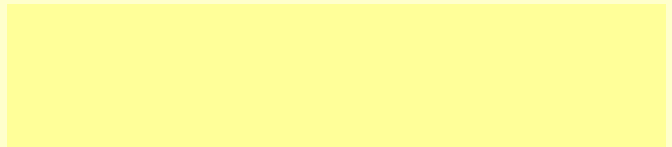
- Counting from zero to 10.
